Step	Public Notice and Comment Requirements for Information Collection Requests	
1	Develop proposal to collect information	
2	60-day Federal Register notice (ended October 27, 2014)	To obtain the public's input on an agency's proposal to collect information, the agency publishes a 60-day notice in the <i>Federal Register</i> soliciting public comment on the agency's proposed collection. The notice must include a specific request that the public evaluate whether the proposed collection of information is necessary; evaluate the accuracy of the agency's estimate of the burden that the collection would impose on respondents; comment on how to enhance the quality, utility, and clarity of the information to be collected; and comment on how to minimize the burden of the collection of information.
3	Consideration of the public's comments from 60-day Federal Register notice	
4	30-day Federal Register notice and submit to Office of Management and Budget for review (planned notice late November 2014)	After conclusion of the 60-day comment period and the agency's internal consideration of the public's comments, the agency submits the collection to OMB and publishes a second <i>Federal Register</i> notice to announce the start of OMB review. This second notice informs the public about how to submit comments to OMB and informs the public that OMB may act on the agency's request only after the 30-day comment period has closed.
5	Consideration of the public's comments from 30-day Federal Register notice in conjunction with Office of Management and Budget
